The course will address the questions and challenges and provide the updates and pearls in diagnostic pathology that practicing pathologists encounter in day-to-day practice, help the practicing pathologists to avoid the commonly encountered diagnostic errors and become proficient different subspecialties, and help residents and fellows with their subspecialty board exam preparations.
